# Why Sponsor Netball?

- Netball is the highest participation sport in Alice Springs boasting over 850+ players & officials.
- Netball is the highest female participation sport in Australia
- Netball Australia are making a substantial push to be included in the 2032
   Olympics and therefore increasing the participation in Boys and Mixed Netball
- Alice Springs Netball Association (ASNA) has members ranging from 5 years old to 70 years old
- The majority of these members are aged 8-17 years with 468 juniors registered in 2022
- Netball is inclusive our current programs run throughout the year and include
  - Net Set Go (5-10 years old)
  - Underage Competitions (11-17 years)
  - Senior Competitions
  - Mixed Netball Competitions
  - All Abilities Program
  - Junior Development Programs
  - Junior Umpire Development Program
  - Toddler Sport Programs
  - Walking Netball
  - School Incursions and Competitions
- Active social media accounts with over 1600 followers on Facebook and the recently launched ASNA Instagram page with followers increasing daily (300+ followers as of May 2021)
- We consistently have local athletes and coaches selected to compete and coach at the Underage National Championships.
- Each year, ASNA sends up to 8 teams to compete in the Northern Territory NT Link Championships. Along with the athletes, umpires, coaches and team managers are selected and given the opportunity to further develop on their skills and passions. ASNA recently competed at the 2022 NT Link Championships winning the Open Women's Championship
- ASNA have recently developed a Strategic Plan for 2022-2026 (See attached) identifying 4 key areas of development

  - Improved Participation
  - Inclusive Competition
  - Fit For Purpose Facilities

#### **Aims of The Association**

Alice Springs Netball Association has clearly outlined an emphasis on creating an inclusive environment and competition in its Strategic Plan for 2022-2026.

ASNA sees three (3) main areas of focus to build a more inclusive environment over the next five years. These are outlined below

- Indigenous Participation ASNA currently has approximately 20% Indigenous
   Participation in the winter netball competition. Best estimates place the Indigenous
   Population of Alice Springs at approximately 25%. ASNA has a goal of increasing the
   above participation to better represent the Alice Springs Community. More
   importantly we want to be a community leader in the sports community in providing
   a safe, inclusive, and welcoming environment.
- **Multi-Cultural Participation** Alice Springs has a very large and growing multi-cultural community. As for Indigenous participation ASNA aims to be a community leader in providing a culturally safe environment for these populations.
- All-Abilities Pathway The Thorny Devils is the all-ability pathway of the Alice Springs Netball Association. The Thorny Devils play a weekly game of netball against other ASNA club teams each week during the winter netball season.
